



## National SASU Service Agreement Between The Scouts and SSAGO

A national Scout Active Support Unit (SASU) will operate as a separate entity to the Student Scout and Guide Organisation (SSAGO) to allow SSAGO members to volunteer and support TSA's activities and events.

### **Roles**

The SASU will be managed by the national SSAGO Chairperson as national SASU Manager and the national SSAGO Membership Officer as Unit Coordinator. The national SSAGO Chairperson and Membership officer are appointed through SSAGO voting processes each year (approx. Feb) at the national SSAGO AGM.

### **Membership**

Members of the SSAGO SASU must be members of SSAGO. SSAGO members must follow the Scout Association Policy, Organisation and Rules (POR) as stated in the Memorandum of Agreement.

### **Service provision**

The purpose of the SSAGO SASU is to actively offer support and assistance to local and national events and programme activities that are designed to enhance the Scouting experience of young people across the UK.

### **Disclosures**

The SSAGO SASU manager will be responsible for ensuring all members of the SASU undergo a suitable disclosure check to support and assistance at events when needed. Disclosure checks should be completed in line with POR.

### **Review**

This version on the Service Agreement will be reviewed in May 2018 with the introduction of the new SSAGO Executive Committee. Following that the Service Agreement will be reviewed each year with the introduction of each new SSAGO Exec.
